We dated for 2.5 years before getting engaged.

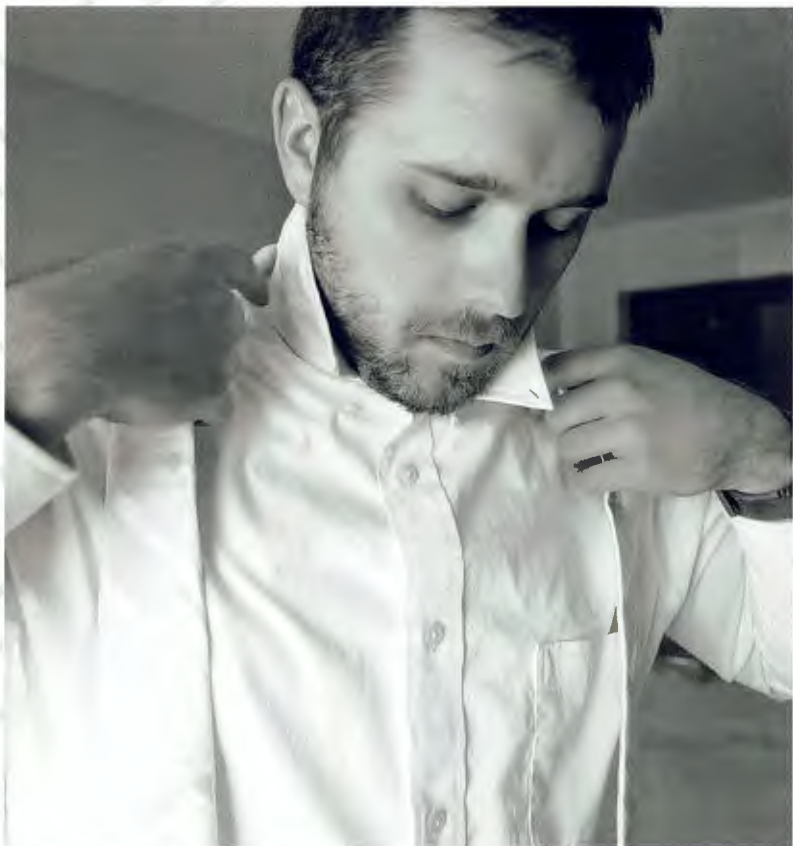
We got married in May of 2017.

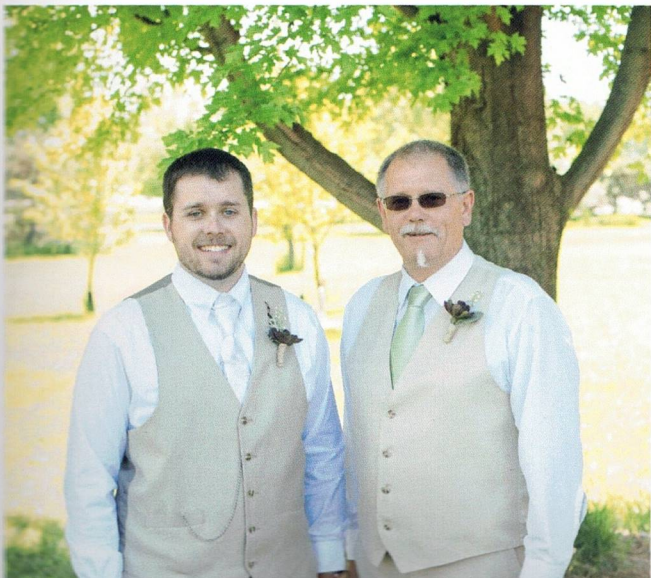
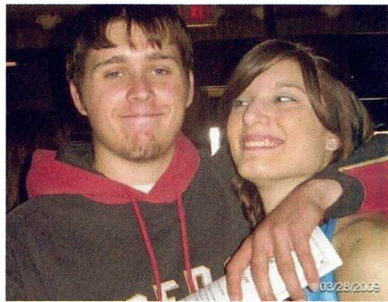
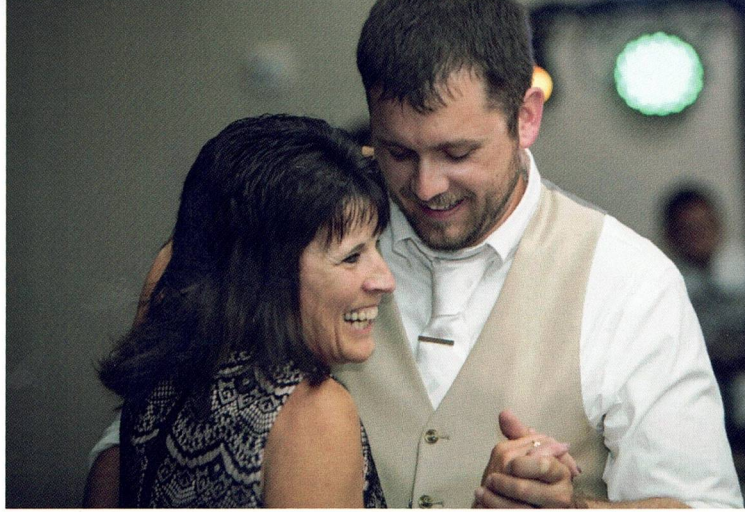


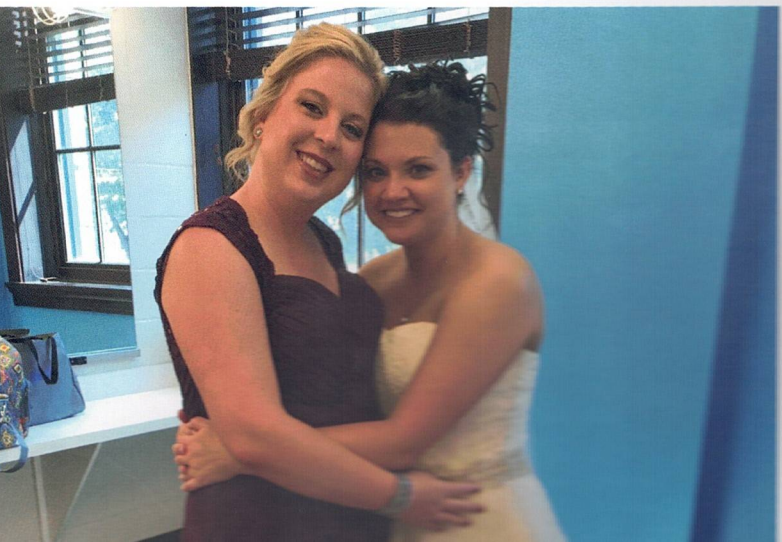
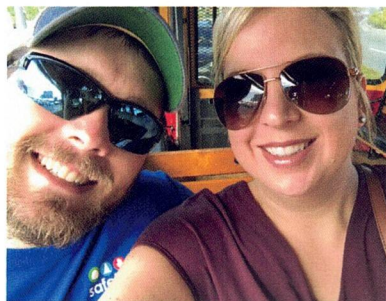
